

SURVEY OF FINAL YEAR CREATIVITY AND BUSINESS INNOVATIONS STUDENTS

Execution time

The survey was conducted in the spring semester of 2025.

Objective

The objective of this survey is to find out the students' attitudes towards studies and prospects for professional activity.

Short presentation of the questionnaire

The final year students evaluated the study programme according to the statements about the studies and acquired skills, which were evaluated on a 5-point scale (5 – strongly agree; 4 – agree; 3 – neither agree nor disagree; 2 – disagree; 1 – strongly disagree). The questionnaire consists of 11 questions formulated as closed-ended and open-ended. The survey was conducted in English. The survey involved 4 out of 11 students in the Creativity and Business Innovations study programme.

Presentation of survey results:

85 percent of the final year students are not currently working, however 15 percent are working but not under the study program.

Rate how much you agree or disagree with the statements on the scale from 1 to 5, where 5 means totally agree, 1 – totally disagree.

What competencies did you develop during your studies?

1. Personal leadership (being able to represent yourself and your work results)	3,8
2. Problem solving (being able to solve problems)	3,8
3. Critical thinking (being able to think critically and analytically)	4,2
4. Creativity (being able to generate (innovative) ideas)	4,4
5. Initiative (being able to motivate, get involved, develop a positive attitude towards the task, work)	4,2
6. Independence and organization (to be able to independently organize your activities)	4,2
7. Responsibility (being able to take responsibility for your actions)	4,0
8. Communication and cooperation (being able to communicate, work in a team, achieve common goals)	4,6
9. Conflict solving (being able to manage conflict situations)	4,4
10. Willingness to improve (to be able to adapt (accept innovations) and to constantly learn, learn from experience)	4,4

Students highlighted the following skills they developed during their studies: communication and cooperation, conflict solving, willingness to improve, creativity, critical thinking, initiative. Personal leadership, problem solving skills in this case were named as less developed.

Up to 80 percent of students in this category agreed that they can work according to the study program.

Students' opinions in this category differed with no clear tendency.

What's next:

Further action plan for developing study program and increasing students' satisfaction:

- Students' doubts and mentioned issues will be addressed during departmental meetings in order to focus on current generation needs and wellbeing. Online and face to face meetings will be continued in order to keep real connection and to face upcoming students' issues in advance.



- The availability of literature and access to information sources in the library will be reviewed and enhanced in accordance with students' basic study needs.
- Some students mentioned they work in non-related to the study program field, even though most of them do work in lower and upper managerial positions in business where they do use most of the study gained knowledge on a daily basis.
