

SURVEY OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS STUDENTS ON LEADERSHIP OF GRADUATION INTERNSHIP

Execution time

The survey was conducted at the end of the spring semester of the academic year 2024-2025.

Purpose

To find out the opinion of International Business students on the Graduation internship, and to use the answers to improve the process of organisation and execution of practices.

Short presentation of the questionnaire

International Business students rated the internship supervisor at the faculty according to 6 statements on a scale from 1 to 5, where 5 means strongly agree and 1 means strongly disagree. The results were analysed by calculating the mean scores. The survey was anonymous and voluntary.

Presentation of survey results:

The overall assessment point average for the practice tutor of the Faculty according to all 6 criteria is 4.3 out of 6 possible points.

I was introduced to the objectives and evaluation of the practice	4.6
The internship tasks were clearly formulated	4.4
Clear deadline terms and forms	4.2
The internship lecturer provided an opportunity for consultation	4.3
Settlement results discussed (written or oral)	4.1
The evaluation shall follow the published evaluation forms and criteria	4.0
Average:	4.3

Positive statements:

The students indicated that they were informed about the objectives and assessment of the practice, that the internship tasks were clearly formulated and the results of the assessments were discussed in written or oral form.

Points to improve:

More focus on the formulation of practice tasks and better clarification of the evaluation forms and criteria.

Student observations

"The practice was useful and professionally rewarding". "During my practice I had the opportunity to put into practice the knowledge I gained during the lectures. It was a great opportunity to get to know the different areas of work, to understand what kind of workplace is suitable"; "The practice went smoothly. There were many opportunities to develop as a person".

(NOTE: students' responses are unadjusted and uncorrected).

What's next?

The students are informed in advance of their forthcoming Graduation internship in order to ensure sufficient time to search for a practice placement appropriate to their study programme and field of study. The Training and Cooperation Development department of the Faculty of Business

A regularly updated database of practice placements for students of the Business Management Faculty is shared with students prior to the internship, allowing students to choose from a wide range of companies.
